

ACTIVITY TIME

Here is an activity you can do before the Family Musical Mornings concert on Saturday. The instructions are below. Enjoy!



Arrr!
Bring your spyglass along
with you to the concert to
spy on the musicians in
the orchestra.

Materials

- ❖ A paper tube (paper towel or gift wrap tube)
- ❖ Construction paper – any color
- ❖ White paper and yellow crayon, or yellow paper
- ❖ Pens or crayons
- ❖ Scotch tape
- ❖ Plastic wrap



Instructions

1. Take a small square of plastic wrap and cover one end of the paper tube. Secure the plastic wrap with tape. This is the 'glass' lens for your spyglass. Don't worry if it is not neat because you will be covering the edges of the plastic wrap in the next step.
2. Test your piece of construction paper by wrapping it around the tube. Cut it so it will wrap easily around the tube.
3. Draw music notes on the cut piece of construction paper. [Click here to see some pictures of music notes that you can copy.](#)



4. Cover the outside of your paper tube with the construction paper.
5. Cut a narrow strip (1 inch) of yellow paper to wrap around the end of your spyglass. You can either cut a strip from yellow paper or from a white paper that you colored yellow.
6. Add a narrow strip of yellow colored paper around the end that has the glass (plastic wrap).
