# ARTS-X-PRESS IN CELEBRATION OF COLE CARSAN ST. CLAIR

### A transformational experience...

arts-X-press is a summer arts immersion program where middle schoolers come together to explore the arts, be themselves and make lasting friendships. Attending arts-X-press is a rare privilege—just 100 students from throughout Southern California are selected each summer. You have been nominated to apply for the

chance to be part of this diverse community of artists and creative thinkers!

During this five-day, residential program, students sleep overnight in the dorms and eat meals in the campus cafeteria at Concordia University Irvine. Our professional staff and enthusiastic counselors live on campus with the students, leading them in arts workshops in state-of-the art arts spaces and in attending professional performances with a chance to check out what happens behind-the-scenes. Unlike many arts programs out there, at arts-X-press, everyone gets the opportunity to play music, sing, make art, act, dance and write throughout the course of the program

Cost: Financial aid is available to all students, based on need, and we are committed to making it possible for all accepted students to attend. The full tuition for arts-X-press is \$900, which covers all costs for the program including room, board and performance tickets. Applications for financial aid will be sent with acceptance letters. NO student will ever be turned away from arts-X-press for financial reasons.

How to apply: Applicants must currently be in 6th, 7th or 8th grade. No previous arts training is necessary. You can go online to <a href="www.PacificSymphony.org/artsxpress">www.PacificSymphony.org/artsxpress</a> and apply there, or download and fill out the application and return it to your teacher or the Symphony office by the deadline.

#### **Application Instructions**

- 1. Fill out **BOTH pages** of the application completely.
- 2. Provide **contact information** for at least ONE parent or guardian.
- 3. **Provide an e-mail address** if you have one. We will send important updates about arts-X-press via email. We promise we won't use it to send you junk mail!
- 4. Please circle no more than three **art forms** you are most interested in exploring at arts-X-press. During arts-X-press, students will get a chance to experience all five of these art forms, but preferences are taken into consideration for primary workshop placement.
- 5. Indicate your availability for all the arts-X-press sessions you are available for. Remember, the **greater your availability, the more likely it is that we will be able to find a spot for you**. If your availability changes later on, we can almost always arrange a session change.

#### Financial Aid

**All students are eligible for financial aid.** Financial aid applications will be sent with welcome letters to accepted students.

Households earning less than \$30,000 annual income automatically qualify for 75% reduced tuition of \$225.

This tuition reduction will be automatically credited to students who qualify with no additional paperwork necessary. All families can also apply for additional financial aid to reduce their cost further.

No student will ever be turned away from arts-X-press for financial reasons.
