Pacific Symphony is the resident orchestra at Segerstrom Center for the Arts, performing more than 80 concerts a year in the heart of Orange County. The Winter subscription series are presented at the Renée and Henry Segerstrom Concert Hall and include Classical, Pops, Family, and Sunday Matinees. Our Summer subscription series is presented at Great Park Live. The Symphony also performs several non-subscription concerts and is the primary orchestra for the Pacific Chorale as well as The Segerstrom Center for the Arts' international ballet series. Additionally, Pacific Symphony produces a wide array of education and community engagement programs that serve the Orange County community.

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Deposits

In addition to an online application, candidates must also mail a \$100 refundable deposit in the form of a check payable to 'Pacific Symphony' with 'Bass Trombone' and their name on the memo line.

Cashier's checks, money orders, cash, and credit card information will not be accepted.

Deposit checks will be returned to applicants when released by the Audition Committee on the day of their live audition but will not be returned to applicants who fail to be present on the day of their scheduled audition. Candidates who notify the Director of Orchestra Personnel of their intent to withdraw from consideration by March 18th will have their deposit check destroyed.

Deposit checks must be post-marked by March 11, 2026.

Email Confirmations and Excerpt Packets

Once deposit checks are matched to submitted Audition Applications, candidates will receive an email from the Director of Orchestra Personnel confirming their inclusion in live auditions March 26-27, 2026. Candidates should refrain from booking travel until the confirmation email has been received.
